Partnership Management

Community Engagement

Community engagement is essential to so much of the work we do as cultural organisations and practicioners, and it is important we understand the communities we're working with and delivering programmes for. I have instigated and facilitated a range of events and workshops with artists to engage members of the public and successfully gathered the data required to inform project planning and fundraising strategy.

I am friendly, outgoing and approachable, making me a natural communicator in a community engagement context. I have experience of researching and reaching out to organisations with shared objectives, such as community groups, charities and other arts and heritage bodies.

I have led a number of projects with a central focus on community consultation, and have experience of being clear about the aims and objectives of what is required from partners and participants.

Writing, Editing and Publication Production

Throughout my career, I have actively sought opportunities to write critically about art. I do this through reviews, interviews and in the text I write for exhibition purposes. I have written for a range of print and online art publications including A-N, Flash Art and This Is Tomorrow.

I have experience of writing interpretive text such as gallery guides and press releases. I have a vast amount of experience of working with colleagues in marketing and PR on the timely publication and dissemination of information relating to forthcoming exhibitions.

I have advanced editorial skills, I have proofed and edited catalogue essays and critical texts, as well as compiling and editing biographical and end material for a range of books, adhering to a range of styles.

I have undertaken picture research, obtaining permissions and copyright clearance from national and international collections and agencies including Bridgeman Art Library, Getty and DACs. In a previous role I administered a collections image library, providing experience of the distribution of images and permission requirements prior to publication. I am also adept at



obtaining and registering ISBNs and logging publications with Legal Deposits.

I have managed the production of numerous publications and exhibition catalogues, working with artists, designers, authors, translators, printers and distributors from concept to delivery. I am passionate about creating books to accompany exhibitions because they form a lasting document, in contrast to the fleeting, ephemeral nature of exhibitions.

I become consumed by design decisions such as sourcing paper stock at the correct weight, deciding on binding and typeface, how to organise the flow of a publication, how the images look against text, creating a logical order to best represent an artist's work or project. Then the final pleasure of poring over the finished article, looking for any unseen errors and breathing a sigh of relief when there are none.

Mentoring

I am passionate about working with early career arts professionals and can help you develop ideas, provide practical advice, support your planning and help you achieve your personal plans.

I have worked with a range of early career curators in the planning and delivery of projects, developed from the very seed of ideas to international touring exhibitions.

I can provide accessible and solid advice on how to make your project happen, from helping you to articulate clearly what you want your project to achieve to providing very practical advice on fundraising, exhibition delivery and publication production. I can give practical hands-on support during installations and events, and be your safety net to ensure that you don't overlook anything important.
